Hi Jessica,

My client is prepared to remove the "SAVE 20%" advertisement from the proposal and is instead requesting approval to extend the lifestyle graphic across the adjacent window. The intent is to visually screen unsightly back-of-house elements such as equipment racking and the backs of retail shelving.


The proposed window graphics would use perforated film, which allows visibility from the interior out, without significantly obstructing the view. This approach has historically been approved as a method to conceal interior support areas (example shown below with black window film). The current proposal simply upgrades this concept to a more aesthetically refined lifestyle image.

The bottom three images illustrate both the exterior and interior conditions, demonstrating how the film functions in practice. Additionally, I've attached the continuation of the proposed graphic for your review.


We're concerned that applying the lifestyle image to only one section of the window may appear unintentional or incomplete. Extending the image across the adjacent pane would create a more cohesive and deliberate visual outcome.

Please let me know if this revised approach would be acceptable and that I am understanding the intention with the code language.
